

# Listed Buildings

Buildings and structures of special architectural or historic interest in the London Borough of Bexley, which appear on the Statutory List as prepared by the Department for Culture Media and Sport

These are shown in street order for ease of reference

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** Alterations to these buildings, or their partial/ total demolition, may require Listed Building Consent. Moreover, works to structures or other engineering operations within the curtilage of a Listed Building, or which are outside the curtilage but effect the setting of a Listed Building, may also require consent. This list should, therefore, only be treated as a guide and **before** starting any works the Council's Development Control Section should be contacted for advice. It is a **criminal offence** to carry out any works requiring Listed Building Consent without the proper authorisation.
