We are writing to you to ask your views on our proposal



We need to make changes to how we work out how much people pay for social care services. This may affect you



We are writing to you because you have services from social care now and have had a financial assessment before to tell us how much you can afford to pay toward your services

Who will the proposal affect?



The changes only affect people who have support from social care and live in their own home



It does not affect people living in residential care or nursing care

It does not affect people who have not needed to pay money towards their care

Would the proposal affect me?



If you pay money towards your care but do not pay the full cost



The changes may be better for you You will not have to pay more because of the changes



If you pay the full cost of your care and we arrange this care for you

The changes will mean we work out what you have to pay in a different way



This might mean how much you pay will change

Some people may have to pay slightly more

Others may pay less
